MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF STUDIES

Resolved that the members of the Board of Studies in Sports Technology have discussed, devised and approved the revised curriculum, Syllabi and regulations of Master of Technology (M.Tech) in Sports Technology programme under the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) offered by the Department of Advanced Sports Training and Technology of this University. The duration of this programme is two years and the total credit requirements are 68 credits along with 12 credits for non-CGPA courses. The members of the board suggested to include Professional Ethics in the audit course. The members also suggested to include case studies under each chapter wherever possible. The detailed curriculum, syllabi and regulations of M.Tech in Sports Technology Programme under the CBCS are appended in this minutes.

Further, it was also noted by the members of the Board that the Master of Technology (M.Tech) is a Technical Programme offered by the *Department of Sports Technology* which has been approved by the *All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE)* since the academic year 2012-2013 onwards and therefore, the Department of Sports Technology cannot be merged

with the Department of Advanced Training and Coaching as these two Departments are not related. Hence, it was unanimously resolved to recommend that the existing Department of Advanced Sports Training and Technology' to be restored as 'Department of Sports Technology' as it was existed at the time of inception of the University (as per G.O.Ms.No.233, Higher Education (K2) Department, Government of Tamil Nadu, dated 21.07.2006) in order to satisfy the requirements of AICTE and also for the benefits of students as the Degree would be awarded under the Department of Sports Technology of this University.
