For joint supervision of research students, the formula shall be 70% of the total score for Supervisor and Co-supervisor. Supervisor and Co-supervisor, both shall get 7 marks each.

- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic affairs) of the University concerned.

Note:

NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Master Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC/CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET

B The Ph.D Degree has been obtained from a Foreign University / institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University ranking (at any time) by any one of the following (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii). The Times Higher Education (THE) (iii) the Academic ranking in World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai)

<u>Note:</u> The Academic Score as specified in Appendix II (Table3A) for Universities and Appendix II (Table 3B) for Colleges shall be considered for short listing of candidates for interview only, and the selections shall be based only on the performance in the interview

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
