- Dr. P. Kumaravelu, Assistant Professor, Department of Physical Education has requested to recognize him as one of the Research Supervisors of this University based on successful completion of Doctorate Degree Accordingly, the said request was placed before the Departmental Research Committee for granting Ph.D., Guideship, the said committee met on 11.12.2018 in the conference Hall and have thoroughly verified the application and supporting documents submitted by Dr. P. Kumaravelu, Assistant Professor, Department of Physical Education, TNPESU. The committee found that the above applicant is eligible for Ph.D., Guideship in Physical Education as per the Doctor of Philosophy Regulation, 2015 of TNPESU and unanimously resolved to recommend the University to recognize the applicant for Ph.D., Guideship in Physical Education.
- Dr. Karilkalan, Principal, St. John's College of Physical Education has submitted his application for recognition of Research Supervisor to this University. While his application was scrutinized by the Departmental Research Committee it was found that research guidance experience was incomplete and he gained research experience during the previous Academic Year 2017-2018. Based on the above, this University has given approval to him for Ph.D., Guideship in Physical Education.
- Dr. Bright Selvakumar, Principal, Christian College of Physical Education was already as one of the research supervisors of this University. Due to new regulations and guidelines of Ph.D., the guideship was temporarily stopped to him. But now the Research Alliance has given special permission to continue to supervise the research scholars.

Approved the following Revised Ph.D., Guidelines

1. As per the University guidelines which is on par with UGC regulations 2015-16, it is mandatory to check plagiarism. The Ph.D thesis reports submitted from the academic year 2018-2019 will be subjected to the plagiarism checking and the same will be in force until further amendments. Further maximum of 20% of similarities in the thesis report will be allowed.
2. The candidates who have cleared NET / SLET are exempted from appearing the entrance test. **However they should score 50% of marks in certificate verification and personal interview.**
3. The scholars who cleared the entrance test will be admitted for Ph.D., based on the merit and the roster system followed by the Tamil Nadu Government which is in force.
4. Every research scholar should complete the course work, and should appear for four doctoral committee meetings during his/her research tenure and they should submit report once in six months till the submission of thesis

5. Each guide is permitted to conduct only two Doctoral Committee meetings, two Pre-Ph.D meetings in a day.
6. Doctoral Committee meeting and pre Ph.D meetings should be conducted after getting confirmation from the Research Coordinator and authorities of the University.
7. The scholar should fill in all the columns of the certificate and sign in the specified column.
8. Head of the Departments and Research supervisor also should sign the certificate before submission of the thesis.
9. The scholar should bring the Thesis in CD/DVD format with a single file containing all chapters except - II- chapter - Review Related Literature.
10. URKUND supports the following file formats - pdf, doc, .docx, .sxw, .ppt, .pptx, .txt, .rtf, .html, .htm, .wps, .odt
11. Limits to submit the document - Every document containing not more than 4,00,000 characters will be considered as one document. If exceeds 4,00,000 Characters then it would be considered as two separate documents.
12. Three hundred rupees (Rs. 300/-) is a fee for single plagiarism checking which should be payable in form of Challan / Demand Draft in favour of Registrar, TNPESU.
13. The plagiarism checking will be allowed only three times per thesis per scholar. More than three times the candidate will not be permitted to submit the thesis.
14. The Research Scholars / Supervisors will not be permitted to change either in the thesis or plagiarism report.
15. It was discussed and decided that the **Tamil Nadu Government reservation policy** (69 % reservation) will be adopted to finalize the reservation for Ph.D admission for different departments and all research centers of this university. As per the table given below

16. It was decided and resolved that those who have joined Ph.D programme in our university before 31st December -2015 is exempted for plagiarism checking.
 17. It was decided and resolved that the Ph.D., admission will be given to the candidates who have cleared the entrance examination. However, if the Research supervisors are not available should apply afresh though they have the candidates have cleared the entrance test.
 18. It was decided and resolved of the research Scholar submits his/her thesis at the verge of submission date or last date of submission, the plagiarism checking should have been completed within a month period. If exceed more than a month period the candidate must pay the fee for the next year.
- Resolved that those who have registered for Ph.D., and not submitted their thesis on time are now permitted to submit their thesis by paying all the tuition fees for all years along with the penalty of Rs. 1000/- on or before December 2019.

CIRCULAR

I am by direction to inform all the recognized research supervisors of the University that the following amendments have been made in the **“Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D) Programme Regulations, 2015”** as per the decisions taken in the **“Research Alliance”** meeting held on 15.10.2020:

1) **Plagiarism:**

The UGC (Promotion of Academic Integrity and Prevention of Plagiarism in Higher Educational Institution) Regulations, 2018 is to be implemented for those scholars who have been admitted from August 2019 onwards.

As per these Regulations, the following penalty shall be imposed considering the severity of the Plagiarism:

- i) **Level 0: Similarities upto 10% - Minor Similarities, no penalty.**
- ii) **Level 1: Similarities above 10% to 40% - Such student shall be asked to submit a revised script within a stipulated time period not exceeding 6 months.**
- iii) **Level 2: Similarities above 40% to 60% - Such student shall be debarred from submitting a revised script for a period of one Year.**
- iv) **Level 3: Similarities above 60% - Such student registration for that programme shall be cancelled.**

Penalty on repeated plagiarism – Such student shall be punished for the plagiarism of one level higher than the previous level committed by him/her. In case where plagiarism of highest level is committed then the punishment for the same shall be operative

2) **Communication through Proper Channel:**

All the Communications related to Ph.D Programme to the University should be routed through proper channel only.

3) **Title of the Thesis:**

As per the existing Ph.D Regulations, the title of the thesis should be decided at the first Doctoral Committee Meeting and the same then be approved by the University. As it is very difficult to decide the title of the study during the beginning of the research work before reviewing previous / existing research studies and also before indentifying the research gap, **a broader research area could be indentified during the first Doctoral Committee Meeting and then the title could be finalized during the second or third Doctoral Committee meeting and then the same to be forwarded to the University for approval.**

6) **Panel of Examiners:**

While submitting the Panel of Examiners to the Controller of Examinations, the research supervisors / guides ensure that none of the examiners are chosen either from our University Departments or from our affiliated colleges. Further, persons working as Assistant Professors for more than 15 years in other Universities or affiliated colleges of other Universities could be considered as examiners. While choosing foreign examiners, the research supervisors have to ensure that persons from foreign origin only are chosen as examiners.

7) Extension of Time for submission of Thesis:

Those who have registered for Ph.D but not submitted the thesis so far are now given the last opportunity to submit their theses by paying tuition fee for all years along with a penalty of Rs 2000/- on or before April, 2021. Thereafter, the registration of such candidates will automatically be cancelled.

The approved Research Supervisors are requested to adhere the above amendments in addition to the existing guidelines and also to inform these changes to your Scholars Concerned without fail.

1)The First and Second amendments of UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of M.Phil/ Ph.D Degrees) Regulations, 2018 will be implemented by the University from the forthcoming Ph.D admission session onwards. Therefore, the Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D) Programme Regulations, 2015 of this University is amended as follows:

- The Candidates who secure 50% of marks in the entrance exam is eligible to attend the interview for admission.
- A relaxation of 5% of marks (50% to 45%) is allowed for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC(Non-Creamy layers)/Differently-abled category in the Entrance Examination.
- The selection of candidates will be based on the marks obtained by them both in the entrance examination and interview subject to the availability of vacancies.

Note: Provided further that, if in spite of the above relaxation, the seats allotted for SC/ST/OBC (Non Creamy layer)/Differently-Abled categories remain unfilled, the concerned Universities shall launch a Special Admission Drive, for that particular category within one month from the date of closure of admissions of General Category. The concerned University will devise its own admission procedure, along with eligibility conditions to ensure that most of the seats under these categories are filled.

- 2) As per UGC's Guidelines, approved Principals working in the affiliated PG Colleges are eligible to avail maximum of 8 Ph.D Seats.
- 3) Fee exemption is granted for those scholars whose study period has been already over but thesis has not been submitted due to COVID 19 lock down up to 30.06.2022 as per UGC's Guidelines.
- 4) The Syllabus for the "Paper on Concerned Subjects" for Ph.D Entrance Examination shall be devised and approved by the concerned Board of Studies of the Department and the syllabus for the "General paper on Teaching and Research Aptitude" shall be devised by a Committee comprises of all the Head of the Departments convened by the Senior Member of the Committee.

5) In order to monitor the Ph.D Viva- Voce Examination proceedings held at Research Centres, an University Observer ^{from the concerned dept} will be nominated by the Vice – Chancellor whenever necessary.








6) All Ph.D Viva - voce examination held at University Departmentsshall be fixed in consultation with the concerned Head of the Department and all reports shall be forwarded to the office of CoE through the concerned Head of the Department.

7) If the concerned Head of Department himself/herself is the Guide, the next senior faculty to be included as a member in the Viva-Voce examination.

8) The Research Supervisors from University Departments/ Research Centers are eligible to register new scholars as follows:

- **For Full Time Ph.D programme:** Minimum of Two Years' service before Superannuation.
- **For Part Time Ph.D programme:** Minimum of Three Years' Service before Superannuation.

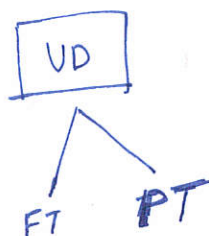

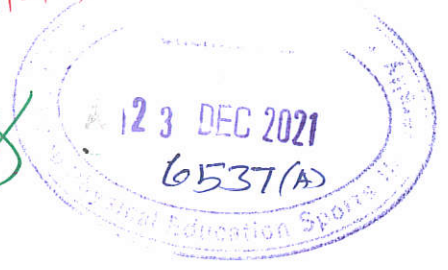

F.No.1-1/2002(PS)Exempt(Pt.Fl.III) Vol-II.—In exercise of the powers conferred under clauses (f) and (g) of sub-section (1) of Section 26 of University Grants Commission Act, 1956 (3 of 1956), the University Grants Commission hereby makes the following Regulations to amend to UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Awards of M.Phil/Ph.D Degree) Regulations 2016.

1. Short title, application and commencement:
 - 1.1. These Regulations may be called the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.D Degrees) (1st Amendment) Regulations 2018.
 - 1.2. They shall come into force from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
2. The following proviso shall be added to the clause 5.4.1 of the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of M.Phil/Ph.D Degrees) Regulations, 2016

“provided that a relaxation of 5 % of marks (from 50% to 45%) shall be allowed for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC(Non-Creamy layers)/Differently-abled category in the entrance examination conducted by the Universities.

provided further that, if in spite of the above relaxation, the seats allotted for SC/ST/OBC(Non Creamy layer)/Differently-Abled categories remain unfilled, the concerned Universities shall launch a Special Admission Drive, for that particular category within one month from the date of closure of admissions of General Category. The concerned University will devise its own admission procedure, along with eligibility conditions to ensure that most of the seats under these categories are filled.”
