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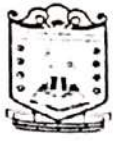

Resolution: The committee thoroughly analyzed the content of the circular and based on the above circular it was resolved to

1. Form Anti Ragging Squad and Anti Ragging Cell in addition to the Anti Ragging Committee.

2. Include the Anti- Raging Warning information and Contact details in the university Calendar and Website.
3. Obtain undertaking from the student and parents to the effect that the student will not indulge in ragging and if found so. will be liable for punishment as per UGC and State government regulations.

Agenda 3 : Discussion on UGC Circular, December 2018

Resolution: The committee thoroughly analyzed the content of the circular and based on the above circular it was resolved to adapt the meaning of the term ragging by including " Any act of Physical or Mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (fresher or otherwise) on the ground of colour, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender(including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic background.

Resolution: The committee thoroughly analyzed and elaborately discussed the content of the Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) regarding the Anti- Ragging in the UGC Website for better understanding of Anti Ragging regulations of UGC.

2. As per instructions of the UGC/Government, the anti ragging Committee meeting shall be convened in the first week of January and in the first day of re opening of the University.

3. It is submitted that the University/ Colleges are likely to be re opened for the second year Students of the Post graduate. MINUTES OF THE ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 01.11.2018.

Minutes of the meeting of the Anti Ragging committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor held on 01. 11. 2018 at 4.00 p.m. in the University Conference Hall to review and strengthen the measures to curb the menace of ragging in the University.

The Committee discussed the UGC regulations, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India instructions and State Government on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions.

The Committee thoroughly reviewed the issue and made the following recommendations:

1. For the academic year 2018-19 directions regarding curbing the menace of ragging, anti-ragging helpline numbers and e-mail helpline, self declaration by the student and his/her parents to the effect that the student will not indulge in ragging, and if found so, will be liable for punishment as per UGC and State regulations, have been informed to all the students of this University departments through respective Heads of the Department and to the Hostels through Warden, Deputy Wardens and Sub Wardens.

2. Posters such as " THE RAGGING IS TOTALLY PROHIBITED IN THE UNIVERSITY AND ANYONE FOUND GUILTY OF RAGGING AND/OR ABETTING RAGGING, WHETHER ACTIVELY OR PASSIVELY, OR BEING A PART OF A CONSPIRACY TO PROMOTE RAGGING, IS LIABLE TO BE PUNISHED IN ACCORDANCE WITH UGC REGULATIONS AS WELL AS UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF ANY PENAL LAW FOR THE TIME BEING IN FORCE" will be printed and pasted at all important places in the University Campus.

3. The committee will arrange to display flex boards carrying anti-ragging message along with important Telephone Numbers at various prominent places in the University Campus.

4 The committee will take action for wide publicity of the measures which the University takes to curb the ragging.

5 All Heads of the Departments of the University have been asked to take self declaration from every enrolled students and their parents in the prescribed proforma regarding anti ragging.

6. The Committee recorded that there were no incidence of ragging during the last and previous academic years. The committee appreciated the fresher's orientation programmes organized by the IQAC to sensitize the fresh students on ragging menace and curbing measures. The committee also appreciated all the Heads of the University and their faculty members for regularly sensitizing and addressing the senior students towards the evils and consequences of ragging.

7. A leaflet incorporating Telephone Numbers of Anti Ragging Help Line, Anti Ragging Committee and Anti Ragging Squads will be printed and circulated to every fresh student admitted.

8. UGC Toll free Anti -Ragging Help line Number 1800-180-5522 and E-mail – help line @ antiragging.net, and the Telephone numbers of University Anti-Ragging Committee, Anti-Ragging Squads, Monitoring Cell and Counselors will be displayed on the University Web-site. In addition official E-mail address of the Vice-Chancellor and Registrar will also be displayed on the University Web-site.

9. Anti Ragging Squads will keep vigilance in Men's Hostels, Women's Hostels and other vulnerable areas of the University. Anti Ragging Squads, constituted for Hostels will also raid

the Hostel in the night. On finding any case of ragging, the squad will report the matter to the Anti Ragging Committee.





10. Anti Ragging Committee will periodically review the status and the information received from Anti Ragging Squads and recommend actions as per UGC regulations.

11. A close watch should be kept on all outside anti-social elements and it should be ensured that they may not enter the University Campus. For this purpose intensive patrolling in the University Campus should be carried out.

12. In every Department a Committee of a few teachers should be formed which may monitor the activities of the students especially during lunch hours/recess and also when they come to the institution and go back to their Hostels/Home. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of any member of above Committee or any other member of the teaching or non-teaching staff, it should be immediately brought to the notice of the authorities.

13. The Non-teaching staff of the University should also remain alert towards incident of ragging. They should report promptly if any case comes to their notice.
