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STUDENT COUNCIL GUIDELINES

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1. Purpose

The Student Council's (SC) purpose is to serve as an effective communication medium between administration and students. The Student Council serves as the interactive body that facilitates main level communication. The Student Council also helps to plan and develop numerous cultural, sporting, social, recreational, and educational interests of the institution's students. The Student Council offers opportunities to contribute to the development of students' leadership abilities, programme planning, and volunteerism.

2. Student Council Constitution

The Institution Students' Council shall consist of the following members, namely: 1. President 2. Vice President 3. Secretary 4. Deputy Secretary 5. Treasurer 6. Deputy Treasurer 7. Executive Council Members.

Faculty Member:

One Senior Faculty as coordinator of the Students' Council, primarily acts as the advisor of the student members in the Student Council.

2.1 Procedure

The nominated posts include all student office bearers. This selection is solely based on the excellence of their leadership initiatives in past years. The Executive Council is largely made up of class representatives who are appointed by the department head in collaboration with their mentors. Priority will be given to achieving appropriate gender balance on the Council.



2.2 Eligibility

1. Nominations are open to all current students enrolled in the university.
2. The candidate shall not have any academic arrears throughout the year of nomination.
3. The candidate must not have faced any disciplinary action by the Institute authorities.

3. The Role of Student Council

The primary role of Student Council is to facilitate the exchange of information between administrative officials and students. The council's aims shall be:

- To promote an educational and personal development environment.
- To assist management, administrative officials, and faculty with institutional development by sharing council opinions, suggestions, and feedback.
- To represent student views on general concerns.

* Student Council cannot influence or amend administrative officials' decision-making procedures.

3.1 Key functions

The functioning of the Student Council should be adhered to the objectives of the council. The council shall work with the administration in the planning and development activities of the students. The key functions are:

- Work closely with the administrative officials, teachers and students
- Should be easily reachable to the students in the institution



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- Involve as many students as possible in the student development activities of the institution

3.2 Office bearers and Responsibilities

Student members of the Student Council have a one-year tenure, whereas faculty members are subject to change due to resignation/termination or any decision made by the Vice-Chancellor in the best interests of the institution's Student Council.

4. Student Council Meetings

The Student Council will convene twice per year (once in the even semester and once in the odd semester). It is obligatory for the faculty co-coordinator to attend Council meetings. The faculty members' support and recommendations will be extremely beneficial in developing the student council members' leadership skills.

4.1 Guidelines

The Student Council meeting must be announced at least two days in advance to its members. The SC meeting cannot be held if the faculty coordinator, President, and Secretary are not present. The meeting minutes must be recorded and made accessible to the Council's Faculty Coordinator after receiving the President's signature. Copies of the meeting minutes will be turned over to the secretary of the next student council at the end of the term.



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4.2 Sample Format of Minutes of Meetings

The minutes of the meetings should clearly reflect the Agenda Points. The format of the Minutes of the Meeting shall comprise the following items :

1. Date, Time and Venue
2. List of the Members Present
3. Details of any Specific Invitees from Administration /Management
4. Agenda Items and Outcomes/Resolutions of the Discussion
5. Next meeting details (If discussed in a specific context)

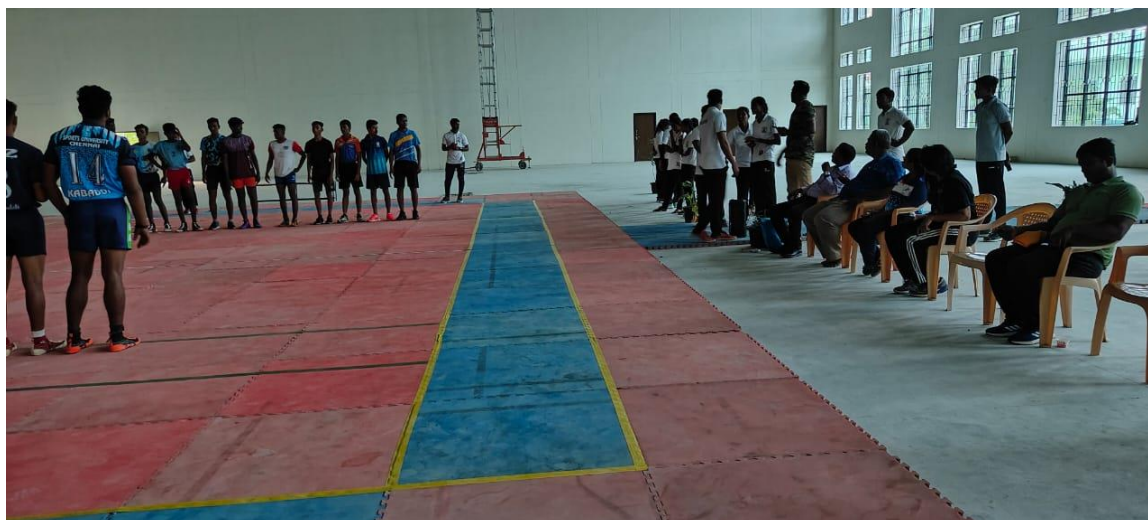
5. Reporting and Dissolution of the Council

The Student Council members are responsible for sharing meeting reports/minutes with the Vice-Chancellor/Registrar/Dean (Student Affairs) at any time.

The Vice-Chancellor may dissolve the entire Student Council (or any individual student/faculty member) at any time (in special circumstances), without prior notice; otherwise, a one-week notice will be issued seeking an explanation to show the cause/explanation for not dissolving the council. The Vice-Chancellor of the Institution always makes the final decision regarding dissolution.
